

The Pyramid Model & Positive Behavior Strategies

- → Focus on Social and Emotional growth and development
- → Teach the child new skills
- → Understand the reason behind the behavior
- → Prevent the occurrence of challenging behavior
- → Support the child in achieving meaningful outcomes
- → Support, as needed, from the Preschool Intervention & Support Team

- → In-Person document submission appointment on one of the following days:
 - Wednesday, March 20
 - Saturday, April 13
 - Friday, April 19
 - Wednesday, April 24
 - Location for ALL days will be at WDMS
 - Additional appointment information will be forthcoming

2024-2025 Preschool 3 Lottery Process

- → Complete the Preschool Lottery Form via the link on the Preschool website, link will close at 3:00 pm on March 15
 - Preschool 3 Lottery Form Link (<u>CLICK HERE</u>)
- → All families who complete the form will be contacted by March 22 with their lottery number
- → The lottery will be conducted on March 26
- → All families who receive an initial seat in the program will be contacted by March 28
 - Next step: In-Person documentation submission on one of the following days:
 - Saturday, April 13
 - Friday, April 19
 - Wednesday, April 24
- → All families who do not receive an initial seat in the program will be placed on a waiting list
